Re: Discretionary Funds of Primate of OCA

Your Eminence:

As you know, this office represents His Beatitude Metropolitan Theodocius personally. We are aware of the auditing process of the OCA's general administrative accounts presently being performed by the Lambrides accounting firm. We are also aware that the private discretionary funds of the Primate, according to the Holy Synod's resolution of 30 July 1999, are not subject to that general accounting audit. However, Metropolitan Theodosius has asked us to have a review of the discretionary funds performed by an independent accounting firm and to report the results of that review to you, as Treasurer of the OCA.

Consequently, at the request of and on behalf of Metropolitan Theodosius I have retained the services of an independent certified public accounting firm, Hein + Associates LLP, to review the discretionary funds of the primate of the OCA for the years 1996, 1997 and 1998.

I am pleased to inform you that Hein + Associates has completed its review and has reported to me that after reviewing the Statements of Cash Receipts and Disbursements of the Discretionary Funds, in accordance with Statements on Standards for Accounting and Review Services issued by the American Institute of CPAs, there are no material modifications that should be made to the Statements of Cash Receipts and Disbursements of the Discretionary Funds in order for them to be in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles.
